Hello. Welcome to the Summer 2020 Imagine Your Story Reading Club. This year's log and prize procedures will be different from previous years, so please read the instructions carefully.

1. There are 2 separate log sheets. 1 for July and 1 for August. You may turn in one or both of them.
2. To turn each log sheet, you must have recorded at minimum of 7 days of reading on that monthly log. A recorded day is a day where you have read a minimum of 15 minutes.
3. You may turn in each log one at a time, or you can turn in both at the end of August. It will not matter in terms of prizes.
4. When you turn in your log sheet with a minimum of 7 days logged, you will get a free book from the cart and a raffle ticket. After claiming your ticket and book, please be sure to put your log into the contact free box that will be next to the prize cart. Your log must be in the box for your raffle entry to be valid.
5. The log is a monthly log. Please note that this year, there is not a weekly check in, or separate weekly prizes. Please do not turn in multiple logs for the same reader. Each reader is entitled to one July log and one August log.
6. There will be jars for the raffle tickets, each labeled with a picture of the prize you are entering to win. All raffles will be drawn the first week of September, giving you plenty of time to turn your logs in.
7. Want bonus raffle tickets??? For any log you turn in where you have read and logged all of the days on the log, you will get a bonus ticket, giving you more chances to win!!!
8. Log sheets will be available to print at home and will also be available at the library, when the library is able to re-open.
